ADVENTURE ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS: (Activity sessions run for approx. 1½hrs by our competent staff)

Rockwall – Our purpose built wall is run by trained instructors; you will climb to the top of our 6m walls using a safety harness, 11mm static rope and 3 other people as your belay team. A great activity to promote teamwork.

Flying Fox – Zip down our 50m flying fox, travelling through the tree tops and over our green gully (Max weight 120kg)

Initiative Games – A series of fun, but challenging games/scenarios where campers learn teamwork, problem solving, communication and leadership. After each game our insightful staff will analyse their performance and debrief each activity.

Archery – Our archery shed includes modern bows, large targets and a shaded shooting range. Our instructors will promote a safe environment, many turns and ensure that each campers attempt at aiming will be a real hit!

BMX – Using our dirt BMX track, campers take turns in riding, jumping, spinning and sliding their way through our track.

Glider possum* – With a rope attached to your back and in a full body harness, you are hauled up into the air by your friends, giving you a great flying sensation with nothing to hang on to (*can't be run in the same session as leap of faith or crate climb)

Leap of faith* – With nothing but air & an 11m drop in front of you, take the leap of faith, trying to hit our hanging ball.

Crate Climb* – Test your balance, co-ordination and agility by building a tower of crates, climbing as high as you dare.

Vertical Challenge – a 12M vertical obstacle course including Caterpillar Logs, Giant Ladder, Tyre Climb and Knotted Ropes.

ECO Adventure – Based on the school syllabus, our ECO adventure is a guided bushwalk investigating water catchment, native flora, habitats, survival awareness, invertebrates, pollution and give you a real 'taste' of our natural bushland.

Bush Craft – Using general craft and natural bush materials such as nuts, leaves and pine cones, let the campers imaginations run wild. From nature collages to name plaques and beading to bush wind chimes, the possibilities are endless.

Bush Creations – Campers will experience what it is like to work together to create a project only using bush materials.

Night program – Our night programs range from a campfire/night bushwalk, mega trivia, mini Olympics to a movie.

H2O Skirmish – If getting a little wet and dirty is your idea of fun, try our H2O skirmish pack which includes use of a real skirmish site and fun games like capture the flag, last man standing and save the maiden. (Optional: emergency rescue simulation)

Off Track Experience – You will get back to nature and off the beaten track, trying to discover how to survive in the bush. Learning skills in orienteering, teamwork and leadership you will find this activity a great nature and team building experience.

Koala Conservation Experience – Threatened species... Educating & protecting our own koala colony. You may even find one

Laser Tag – Real taggers, real skirmish site, real fun and none of this getting wet business. (Cannot be run at the same time as H2O)

Abseiling – Conducted on a natural cliff, our 2 sites involve a controlled descent down into the valley. Offering a 6m and a 20m site, our instructors will encourage your group to push themselves to the limit, gain a new sense of achievement and experience.

Giant Swing – Our 15m swing will really test your screaming levels, swinging you out over a cliff and enjoying the view of the Georges river, the escarpment and the valley way down below you. How will your nerves cope?

Mountain Biking – This guided ride will help you explore our beautiful bushland setting on one of our mountain bikes. Only a basic riding level is needed and our instructor will be able to explain how to ride 'off road' and 'off the track'.
